Established in 1993, The Laurel Foundation is committed to providing year-round, educational, mental health, and social support programs to transgender/gender diverse youth and children, youth, and families affected by HIV/AIDS. Through compassion and hope, The Laurel Foundation allows the children and youth we serve to experience the magic and wonders of childhood free from the stresses of their daily lives. The Laurel Foundation teaches children to believe in themselves and to understand each one of them has the ability to make his or her life as full and rich as the next child's regardless of their gender identity or illness.

We have a one-week session for our transgender/gender diverse youth (6-17) in Mountain Center, CA (July 31-August 6) and a one-week session for our youth affected by HIV/AIDS (6-17) in Angelus Oaks, CA (August 7-14, 2021).

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Nurse, Nurse Practitioner, Physician's Assistant or Physician licensed in CA
- Minimum 4 years resident camp experience working as a medical professional
- Recent experience working with HIV/AIDS and gender diverse patients
- Familiar with HIV/AIDS medications and various hormone therapies for our transgender/gender diverse youth



- Knowledge of inclusive language
- Ability to supervise volunteer medical staff and dispensing of medications
- Desire and ability to work with children in a camp setting
- Positive communication, supervision, and support skills with volunteers
- Good character, integrity, and ability to adapt to the camp setting
- Maintain a professional and confidential manner at all times

RESPONSIBILITIES:

This position is under the general direction of the Camp Director and Medical Advisors on the Executive Board of Directors. Responsible for all camp medical matters pertaining to the safety of everyone at camp. The position is responsible for supervising all medical volunteers, training medical volunteers for Med. Shed procedures, inventory of medical supplies, medication disbursement at programs, procedures, care, etc. This position performs confidential assignments pertaining to job responsibilities. Responsible for training and supervision of medical volunteers.

DUTIES:

- Attend our 2021 summer resident camp programs from July 31-August 14, 2021
- Oversee camp's medical program
- Review camper/volunteer medical applications prior to camp session
- Review applications of new medical staff prior to camp session
- Responsible for supervision of volunteer medical staff
- Comply with state and local health guidelines and ACA Standards with regard to medical care and COVID guidelines
- Responsible for scheduling and documenting and timely disbursement of medication and care for campers and volunteers
- Responsible for ordering and stocking medical supplies

STIPEND:

The Medical Director will receive a stipend of \$2,500.
