

## COVID-19 POLICY

Dated April 28, 2021

This summer at camp we are making every effort possible to create a COVID-19 free environment. The following is a list of policies that we ask all campers, volunteers and staff to adhere to. Thank you for your understanding.

### FULLY VACCINATED VOLUNTEERS AND CAMPERS

1. Fully Vaccinated volunteers and campers must send proof of vaccination to The Laurel Foundation at least 2 weeks prior to camp session.
2. Fully vaccinated volunteers and campers DO NOT need to quarantine prior to camp, but as they can still carry the virus, we ask that you limit your gatherings to people in your household or only gather with those who are fully vaccinated **for 7 days prior to camp**.
3. If a volunteer is diagnosed/exposed/tests positive for COVID-19 at camp, they will be quarantined and it is their responsibility to find a way home the same day.

### UNVACCINATED CAMPERS

4. Unvaccinated campers must limit their activity to just people in their household for 7 days prior to camp.
5. If you plan to travel prior to camp, we ask that you quarantine with just members of your household **for 7 days prior to camp**.

### ALL CAMPERS AND VOLUNTEERS

6. If you have a COVID-19 exposure before camp, you must test 5 days after exposure and quarantine until the 7th day and test results are back. Test results must be sent to The Laurel Foundation before the beginning of camp.
7. If you have a positive COVID-19 test, you must complete 10 days of self-quarantine before you will be allowed to attend camp.
8. Five days prior to camp, ALL CAMPERS will be asked to complete a Daily Symptom Check List. If you answer YES to any of the screening questions, please call The Laurel Foundation immediately. These check lists must be sent to The Laurel Foundation the day before camp begins.
9. The Laurel Foundation will conduct an outreach screening via phone with each camper the day before camp.

### ALL CAMPERS

1. All campers need to arrive at camp under their own transportation. Due to COVID restrictions, this year we will not be providing transportation for campers.
2. If a camper is diagnosed/exposed/tests positive for COVID-19 at camp, they will be quarantined and it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to pick up the camper the same day you are notified by The Laurel Foundation.

To confirm your spot at camp/or on the wait list, you must agree to the above policies.
